2. State Government is advised to ensure that grants released are utilized as per the "Guidelines for Release and Utilisation of Grant recommended by Thirteenth Finance Commission (FC-XIII) for Rural and Urban Local Bodies (Local Bodies Grant)" issued vide letter number 12(2)FCD/2010 dated 23rd September, 2010.
3. States have to transfer above amounts to local bodies within five days of receipt from the Central Government in case of states with easily accessible banking infrastructure and ten days in case of states with inaccessible banking infrastructure. Any delay will require the State Government to release the instalment with interest, at bank rate of RBI, for number of days of delay.
4. You are requested to advise the Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur to credit the above amounts to the accounts of the respective State Governments.
5. The payments are adjustable in the accounts of the Ministry of Finance under the Major Head 3601.01.104.05.00.31 Grants-in-aid to states for Local Bodies Grants in Demand No.35 - Transfers to State and Union Territory Governments for 2011-12.
6. The progressive total of the amounts released to the State Governments under this head so far, including the amounts being released in this sanction order during current financial year 2011-12 is as under:-
