Sir.

In continuation of our letter cited above, I am directed to say that Government of India has recently released Rs.52.60 crore as 1<sup>st</sup> instalment of 2008-09 only against our utilization certificate for Rs.245.73 crore being 73.71% of Rs.315.60 crore released by Government of India for PRIs out of the four remaining installments relating to 2008-09 and 2009-10. This has deprived us of Rs.157.80 crore for the three remaining instalments, although we have achieved minimum required target of 70% of total grants released by Government of India up to 10.07.2009 as per Government of India's instruction issued vide letter No. 12(6)/FCD/2005 dated 05.10.2009.

Now, we are submitting utilization certificate for Rs. 310.50 crore against the grant of Rs.315.60 crore so far released by Government of India up to 10.07.2009 for PRIs under the award of Twelfth Finance Commission in a consolidated statement at Annexure –II. This constitutes 98.38% of total grants released by Government of India for PRIs under TFC grants.

As regards grants of Rs.33.00 crore for ULBs so far released by Government of India till date, we are now submitting utilization certificate for Rs.23.56 crore, which constitutes 71.39 % of total grants released by Government of India. This is also indicated in the format at Annexure –II.

In view of above, you are requested to kindly release the balance installments of grants due to the State Government under award of TFC for local bodies.
